The 1997 FDA guidance document has led to an international shift in paradigm, namely, from the dependence of empirical findings with animals in vivo to mechanistic-based experimentation with human-based experimental models, allowing further development of in vitro-in vivo extrapolation approaches to better our ability to predict clinical outcomes. Our work is not yet done as there remain myriad challenges, but great strides have been made.

We in our 22nd year of DDI will highlight the science and discoveries with presentations by leading scientists with major contributions in the scientific understanding and technological advances of the field of drug-drug interactions, and practical applications of the state-of-the art scientific approaches in drug development.
